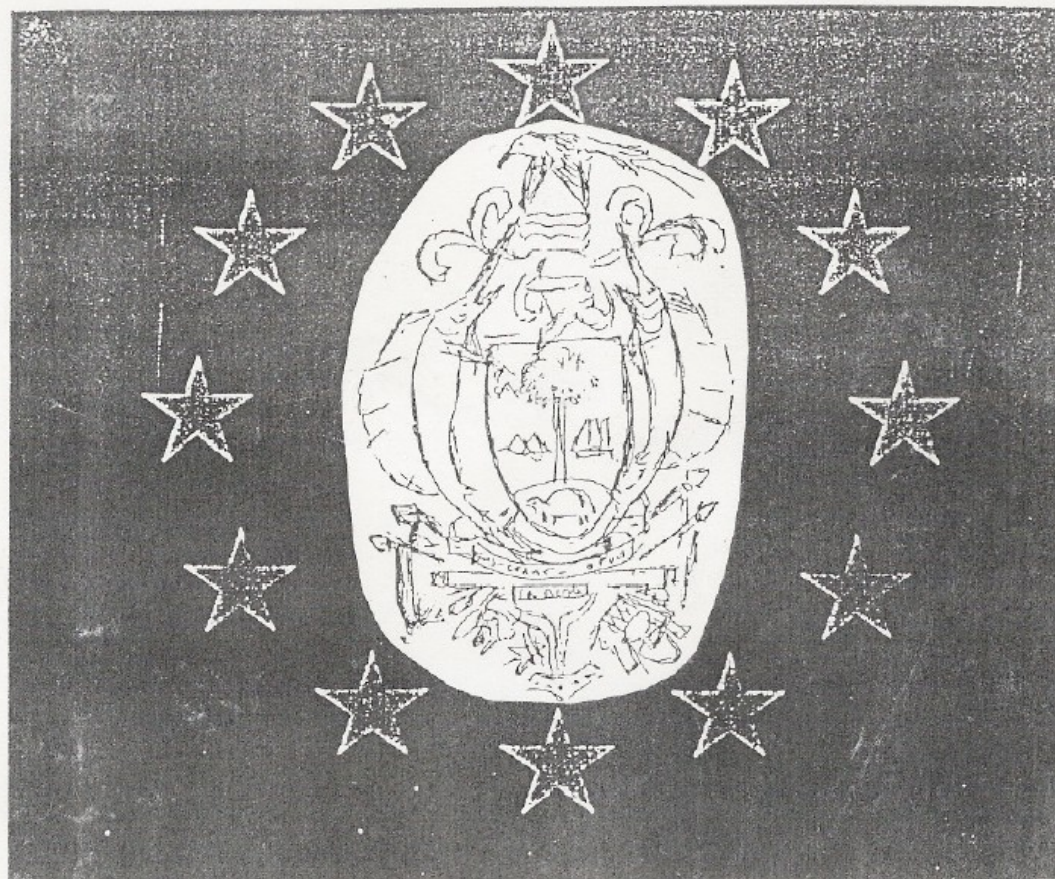

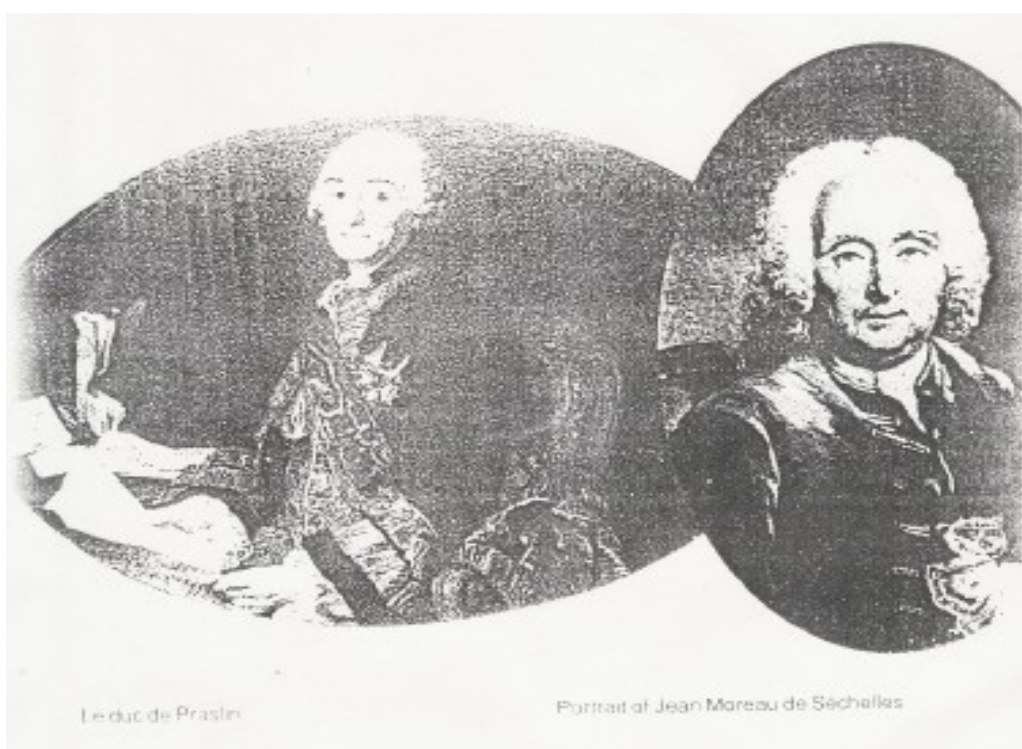

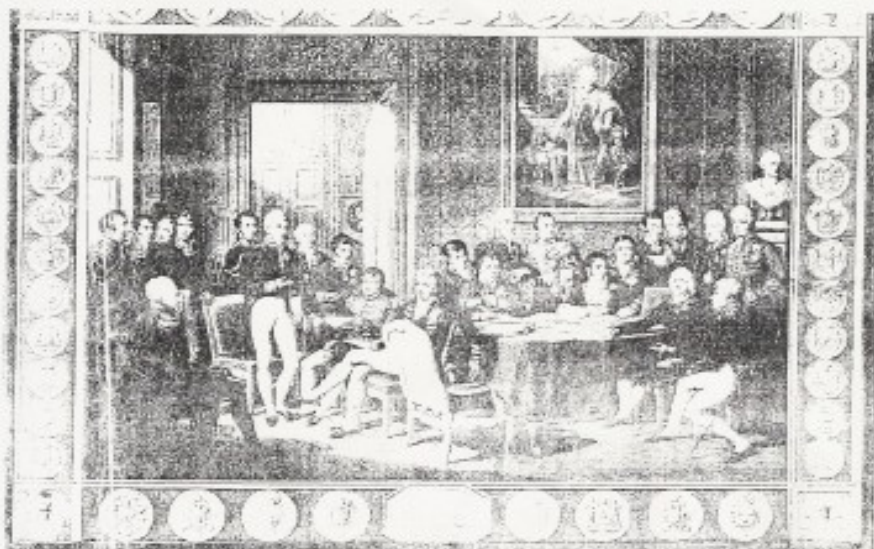

The Congress at Vienna

The Congress of Vienna was a Peace Conference which settled the affairs of Europe after the defeat of Napoleon. Wellington led his army of 68,000 men to Paris in order to force French abdication and to force France to accept the terms of the Treaty of Fontenay-aux-Roses. In the February of 1815, the Congress of Vienna was opened by Lord Liverpool.

In March 1815, Napoleon returned from Elba and landed at Golfe-Juan. The allies of Napoleon's empire joined the Congress together, and all parties determined to restore Europe to the general peace. The British and Napoleon's allies, in the end, won their aim. Wellington, with his army of 68,000 men, defeated Napoleon at Waterloo.

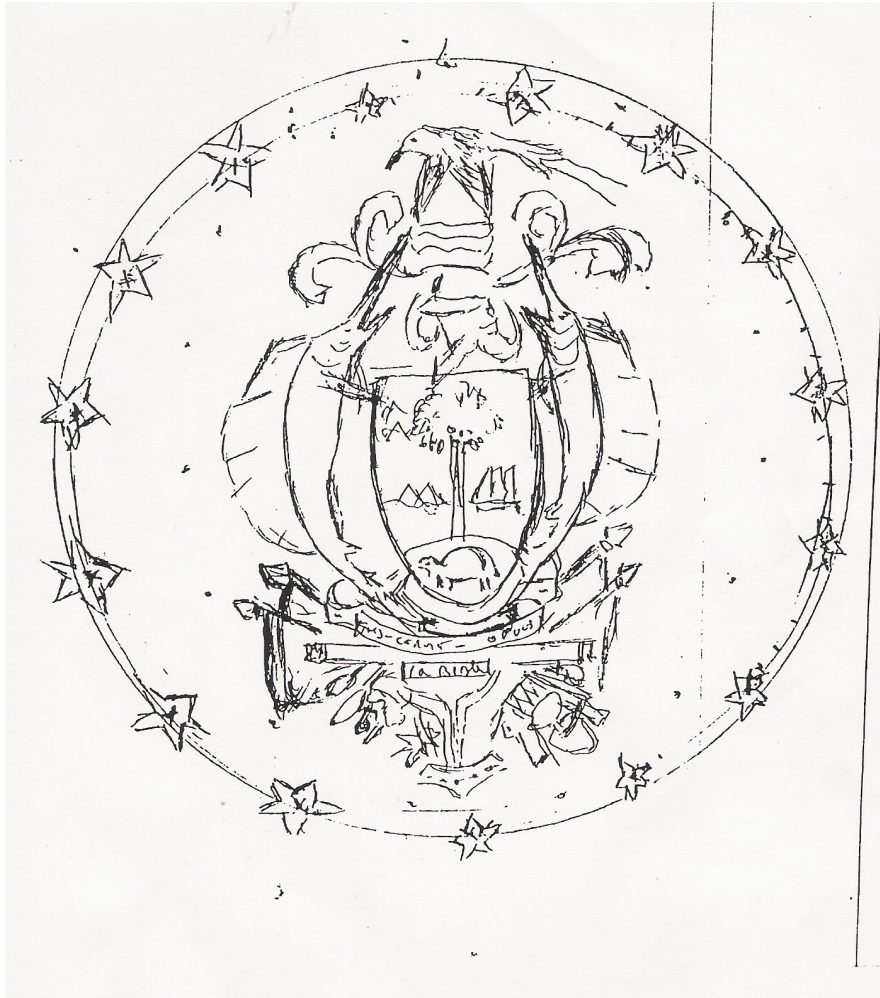
